

Computer Lab Procedures

- ✓ No students may be in the room during any time of the day unattended.
- ✓ If you bring a CD or flash drive from home to use, you must scan the disk for viruses before using it in a school computer.
- ✓ Do not download anything from the Internet without permission.
- ✓ If you have a question or problem that you cannot resolve yourself, place the red cup next to your computer and I will respond as quickly as possible.
- ✓ Only print selections from the Internet that you need to have a hard copy of. Try to conserve paper and ink. Another option is to copy and paste needed info to a WORD document instead of printing. Proofread before printing!
- ✓ No food or drink will be allowed near the computers. Gum is permitted as long as it is handled properly.
- ✓ Students may not modify any settings on the computer.
- ✓ Do not visit unacceptable Internet web sites or chat rooms. If you accidentally open an inappropriate site, tell the teacher immediately.

HOMEWORK POLICY

1. Assignments must be turned in on time for full credit.
2. There will be a one-day grace period for 75% credit allowed.
3. Any assignments not turned in after the one-day grace period will receive a ZERO.
4. There is an exception for excused absences where two days of make-up are allowed per day missed as the student handbook states.

6. Any student who is failing one or more classes will be required to attend Opportunity Room until he/she is again passing all classes.

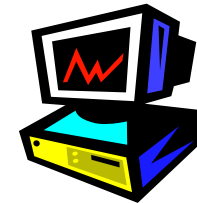
